- 4) No electricity is provided and none shall be used.
- 5) Organizations must provide trash receptacles for waste generated by their booth and remove all operational waste from the premises upon departure. IMPROPER TRASH DISPOSAL IS GROUNDS FOR EXCLUSION FROM PARTICIPATION IN FUTURE EVENTS.
